    - This committee also has a dotted-line connection back to the **Children's Services Partnership Board**.
  
- **Above the Child Protection Committee**, connected by a double-ended arrow, is:
  - **Chief Officers Group – Public Protection**
    - This group connects via a dotted line back to the **NL Partnership Board**.
